MSPH 0600 Evaluating Health Interventions Science	A significant challenge in evaluating health interventions is the complexity of the health system and the multiple factors that influence health outcomes. Additionally, the intervention may be part of a larger system of care, making it difficult to isolate its specific impact. The evaluation process requires careful planning and data collection to ensure that the intervention is evaluated fairly and accurately.
